

**Notice to Bidders**  
(Solicitation for Bids)

Notice is hereby given that the Tulsa Airports Improvement Trust (“TAIT”) will receive sealed bids until **2:00 pm (Local Time) on Tuesday, November 22, 2022**, at the office of the TAIT, Room A211, Airline Terminal Building, 7777 Airport Dr., Tulsa, Oklahoma for:

**TIA – Parking Garage Level 1 Electric Vehicle Charging Stations**

at Tulsa, Oklahoma, and at 2:00 pm (Local Time), the proposals will be publicly opened and read aloud in the Conference Room.

The TAIT anticipates this contract may be funded in part by State Grants and Federal Grants.

The TAIT seeks an experienced qualified firm(s) to provide all material, labor, supervision, tools, equipment and incidentals necessary for the installation of Electrical Vehicle Charging Stations and associated electrical and data accessories, to include installation of new electrical lines, via boring, in accordance with plans and specifications. Required tasks include Phase I-A, II-A, I-B, Option 1 and Option 2 as identified on drawings E-4 and E-5.

A Pre-Bid Conference will be held in a TAIT conference room (address above) on **Thursday, November 10, 2022 at 1:00 pm** (Local Time). Attendance is NOT mandatory. Last day for Contractor questions is Thursday, October 17, 2022.

Bids received more than ninety-six (96) hours, excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays, before the time set for opening of bids, as well as bids received after the time set for opening of bids, will not be considered and will be returned unopened.

All bids must be accompanied by a certified or cashier’s check, Bidder’s Bond, or irrevocable letter of credit in the amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the bid, made payable to TAIT; and in the event TAIT shall award the contract to the bidder and the bidder shall fail, within fifteen (15) days from the making of such award, to enter into the contract and furnish the bonds and insurance as required, the amount of the certified check shall be retained by TAIT as liquidated damages; or, if a bid bond or letter of credit is submitted, the amount thereof shall then be immediately due and payable.

The bidder to whom a contract is awarded will be required to furnish public liability and workmen’s compensation insurance, and performance, statutory, and maintenance bonds acceptable to TAIT, in conformity with the requirements of the proposed contract documents. The performance, statutory and maintenance bonds shall be for one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price.

The TAIT reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any minor technicalities in bidding. No bid may be withdrawn for a period of ninety (90) days after the opening thereof.

The TAIT, in accordance with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (78 Stat. 252, 42 USC §§ 2000d to 2000d-4) and the Regulations, hereby notifies all bidders or offerors that it will affirmatively ensure that any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises will be afforded full and fair opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, or national origin in consideration for an award.
